

AMENDMENT TO SUPERINTENDENT'S CONTRACT ADDENDUM

By mutual consent of the parties in the manner permitted by Ind. Code 20-28-8-6, this agreement amends the Superintendent Contract executed on October 29, 2018, for the employment of Jerry Sanders as Superintendent.

The parties agree that this Amendment will be attached to and made part of the Superintendent Contract. The Superintendent Contract shall be considered amended as of the date this Amendment is approved by the Board. All other terms and conditions of the Superintendent Contract, will remain in effect, unless as specified by this Amendment.

1. Amendment to Section 2. After the last sentence of paragraph 1 of Section 2 of the Superintendent Contract, a paragraph shall be added stating:

The parties agree to extend the term of the Superintendent's Contract for one year, beginning July 1, 2021, and concluding on June 30, 2022, subject to the terms of this Superintendent Contract and all amendments to the Superintendent Contract.


2. Amendment to Section 4(a). After the first sentence of Section 4(a) of the Superintendent Contract, a paragraph shall be added stating:

Beginning July 1, 2019, the Superintendent shall be paid an annual sum of \$125,000.00 for the School Year beginning July 1, 2019, and ending June 30, 2020, subject to normal tax withholding, paid in equal installments on the regular pay schedule for RBBCSC for its employees.


Beginning July 1, 2020, the Superintendent shall be paid an annual sum of \$130,000.00 for the School Year beginning July 1, 2020, and ending June 30, 2021, subject to normal tax withholding, paid in equal installments on the regular pay schedule for RBBCSC for its employees.


This Amendment to the Contract was approved at a meeting of the Board of School Trustees on the 23rd day of March, 2020.


