We have made important changes to the Hybrid Schedule designed to increase student/teacher face to face time and to enhance the instructional process for Edgewood students.

Our goal is always to safely have students in school as much as possible.

The window for changing from in-school to all-virtual or from all-virtual to in-school is between now and January 8th. Please email your student's school to make any changes. We will monitor emails over the Christmas break.

Please be prepared for the possibility that the COVID situation in our community may require RBB to continue with the eLearning schedule. We will confirm our schedules on December 30th.

We will continue to monitor the data on the Indiana State Health Department's Dashboard, work with the Monroe County Health Department, communicate with other school corporations, continue deep cleaning, and stay diligent in implementing important safety measures.

Junior High School and High School Schedule

Starting January 4th: Revised Hybrid Schedule—Yellow Level

Students return to their Blue and Orange Teams.

Important Changes to Hybrid Schedule:

- Students will alternate between physically coming to school and doing eLearning every other day.
- Each student day of In-School Direct Instruction will be followed by an eLearning day.
- eLearning Day activities or assignments will support the previous day's direct instruction.
- EJHS and EHS are revising their daily class schedules so that students will see their teachers every day that they are in-school.
- No Delayed Start Wednesdays.
- With 50% of students in school on any given day, custodians will be able to conduct Deep Cleaning before, during, and after school.

Virtual School Academy

Third Nine Weeks

The Virtual School Academy will continue to be made available to any student who has social distancing, health or other COVID-19 related concerns regarding in-school instruction.

Options for in-school or virtual school is a semester long commitment.

Please note that true distance (virtual) learning is not eLearning. The rigor and course load will be the same as those attending in-person school each day. However, the virtual school is not synchronous with the in-person school day.

Students enrolled in the Virtual School will not have opportunities for extra curricular or co-curricular activities taking place on RBBSC campuses.

Delivery of instruction for the elementary Virtual Academy will be provided through an online format by R-BB teachers.

Delivery of instruction for the secondary Virtual Academy will be provided through Apex Learning.
