

Contingency Learning and Safety Plan

RBBCSC is committed to doing our best to address the academic, mental health, and safety needs of our students and staff. Our plan is a living document that is subject to change based on current situations related to the impact of COVID-19 or other communicable diseases.

Safety Measures

- Mask are optional at all Edgewood schools and all RBBCSC buses for the 2023-2024 school year.
 - RBBCSC may reinstate a mask mandate for a bus, class, school, or the corporation as a response to a surge in positive cases and/or future federal, state, and county health orders.

Periods of High Transmission

- RBBCSC reserves the right to implement mitigation strategies during periods of high transmission of COVID-19 or any communicable disease in a classroom, at school, or throughout the corporation/community.
- Additional mitigation strategies may include increased distancing, contact tracing, quarantining, temporary masking, testing, and other appropriate measures.

Positive COVID-19 Cases

- **PreSchool-Grade 12**
 - Students and staff (regardless of vaccination status) who test positive for COVID-19:
 - ✓ Stay home for 5 days.
 - ✓ Return on or after Day 6 under the following conditions:
 - Must be asymptomatic for 24 hours.
 - Must be fever free for 24 hours without medication.
 - May resume extracurricular activities on or after Day 6.

Visitors

- Visitors are permitted past the school office at the discretion of the building administrator.

Social Distancing Strategies

- School will promote social distancing as much as possible.

The following are additional considerations taking place during the 2023-2024 school year.

- Facial Coverings are optional on the bus.
- Students will only be able to ride on their designated buses-no exceptions.
- Students may be required to wear school appropriate facial coverings on the bus during periods of high transmission.
- Students may be assigned a specific seat. If so, students must remain in that seat throughout the route.

Field trips

- Field trips are permitted at the discretion of the building administrator.

Delivery of Instruction

- Delivery of instruction will be in-person for the 2023-2024 school year in all Edgewood Schools.
 - RBBCSC may implement eLearning instruction for a limited time during periods of high transmission.

Special Education

- Case conferences will be held in-person unless virtually is the most appropriate choice based on the situation. .

Use of Facilities by Community Based Organizations

- Outside organizations providing our community with established after school programs for students may use RBB facilities.
