Dear Parents and Guardians,

All students entering the 6<sup>th</sup> grade are required to be vaccinated for Tetanus, Diphtheria, and Pertussis (**Tdap**), Meningitis (**MCV4**), and are also highly recommended to be vaccinated against Human Papilloma Virus (**HPV**).

The Monroe County Public Health Clinic is working with your child's school to make these vaccinations available to all 5<sup>th</sup> grade students. If your child does not have insurance coverage or has Medicaid, there is not a charge for the vaccine. If your child has insurance that covers vaccines at any level, we will bill your insurance company.

If your child is at least 10 years of age and you would like for them to be vaccinated at school, please do the following:

- Complete the attached paperwork.
- Be sure to include insurance information, if applicable.
- Sign below and indicate what vaccines you are authorizing your child to receive.
- Check the date of your school's clinic and return all completed paperwork to your school by the paperwork deadline date.

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Dear Parents and Guardians,

All students entering the 12<sup>th</sup> grade are required to be vaccinated with two doses of Meningococcal A (**MCV4**), and are also recommended to be vaccinated with two doses of Meningococcal B (**Men B**) and two to three doses Human Papilloma Virus (**HPV**) (number of doses depends upon the age the series is started).

The Monroe County Public Health Clinic is working with your child's school to make these vaccinations available to all 11<sup>th</sup> grade students. If your child does not have insurance coverage or has Medicaid, there is not a charge for the vaccine. If your child has insurance that covers vaccines, we will bill your insurance company.

If your child is at least 16 years of age and you would like for them to be vaccinated at school, please do the following:

- Complete the attached paperwork.
- Be sure to include insurance information, if applicable.
- Sign below and indicate what vaccines you are authorizing your child to receive.
- Check the date of your school's clinic and return all completed paperwork to your school by the paperwork deadline date.
