Procedure for Public Comment

- To permit fair and orderly public expression, the Board requests you be respectful of others while they are making public comment.
- The presiding officer of each Board meeting at which public participation is permitted shall administer the procedures of the Board for its conduct.
- Public participation shall be permitted as indicated on the order of business and at the discretion of the presiding officer.
- Participants must be recognized by the presiding officer and must preface their comments by an announcement of their name and group affiliation, if and where appropriate.
- Public comments are limited to three (3) minutes.
- The presiding officer may interrupt, warn, or terminate a person's statement when that statement is too lengthy, personally directed, abusive, obscene, or irrelevant.
